

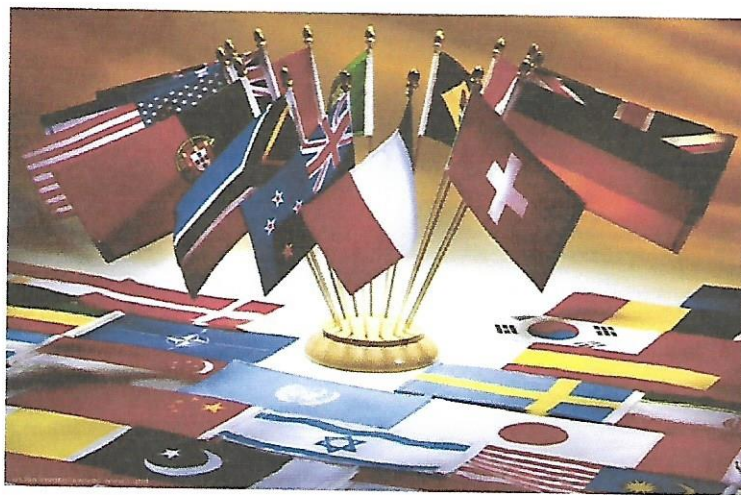


My future profession
